Year 7 Team Challenge Trip to Portsmouth

I am arranging to take Year 7 students to Portsmouth Historic Dockyard's Action Stations. This trip endeavours to develop communication, leadership and negotiation skills through challenges such as flight simulators and climbing walls. Teams will work together to complete each activity whilst working on their observation, awareness and hand-eye coordination.

There will also be time to take part in Laser Quest; developed by the UK's leading laser tag developer and inspired by the Action Station's movie as well as the Royal Navy and Royal Marines. You'll have to face off against your opponent in the bridge of a hijacked container ship and a pirate stronghold with funky lighting effects, billowing smoke and a heart-pounding atmosphere.
