

Addendum to Behaviour Policy due to Covid-19

When students are in school, we expect them to follow all of the rules set out in the behaviour policy. Due to Covid-19, there are additional rules to follow for health and safety reasons.

Staff will be familiar with these rules and make sure they are followed consistently.

Parents should also read the rules and ensure that their children follow the new procedures that have been put in place. Parents should contact their child's tutor in the first instance if they think their child might not be able to comply with some or all of the rules, so we can consider alternative arrangements with them and support them to integrate back into school life.

The additional rules will be:

- Entering the site as per instruction – each year group has its own entrance/exit
- Waiting in the designated year group space before the start of school
- Following the hygiene guidance given to them by any member of staff. These will include distancing, hand sanitizing, cleaning workstations. Should a student need to leave the classroom then they will be issued with a disposable paper note as opposed to using the teacher's yellow lanyard
- Following the guidance on sneezing, coughing, tissues and disposal ('catch it, bin it, kill it') and avoiding touching their mouth, nose and eyes with hands
- Following the one-way system at all times
- Only going to designated zones at break and lunchtime as per instruction
- Telling an adult if they are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus
- Not to share equipment or food with any other person
- Not to sneeze, cough or spit towards any other person
- Exiting the site as per instruction – each year group has its own entrance/exit
- Waiting in the designated area for buses as per instruction – each year group has its own waiting area

We expect everyone to follow these rules in the interests of keeping everyone safe. The staff will offer regular reminders and encouragement. Students wilfully breaking these rules will be subject to the normal Wyvern St Edmunds' behaviour policy.

Wilful disregard for the new rules

- in lessons will result in the student being sent to the Reflection Room
- during non-teaching time will result in the student being given a Friday's Deputy's Detention
